- PRIEST: With confidence in the knowledge of God's love for us we offer up our prayers, for our needs and the needs of our world.
- READER: For Pope Francis and all in leadership the Church, that they may preach the Good News of Christ with courage, truth and compassion. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For all in positions of authority in the world, that they will always seek to govern with integrity and work towards peace, with justice. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For all who are victims of crime, that their wounds of fear may be healed and that they may regain peace of mind. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For families and communities torn apart by suspicion and recrimination, that hate may turn to love and violence to peace. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For our own parish community, that the example of our words and actions may encourage others to join us at the table of the Lord. (*pause*) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For the sick and the suffering, the dying and the bereaved, that they will know the loving touch of Christ in their lives. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- PRIEST: God our Father, you hear our prayers with a love beyond all our imagining. Strengthen us with faith in that love that we may always know, and do, your will. We ask this in his name, Christ our Lord.
