may know that they are chosen and loved by God.

READER: For all who are sick or housebound, elderly or vulnerable,

and especially those close to death,

that they will be comforted by the knowledge of Christ's love.

PRIEST: God our Father,

you are our strength and our protection.

Open our hearts to your grace

that we may always know, and do, your will.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.
