READER: For all who are sick in body, mind or spirit,

that they may know the peace and comfort of Christ's love.

PRIEST: Lord, with Abraham and Sarah we open wide our hearts to serve you;

with Mary of Bethany we open wide our ears to hear your word;

with Martha we open wide our hands to do your work.

May our prayers today centre our lives on your Son, Jesus Christ,
