PRIEST: Jesus tells us 'ask and it will be given to you; search and you will find'.

We this in mind we bring our needs, and the needs of our world, to the Father:

READER: For the Church, that the Pope, bishops, and all church leaders

will continually seek, and be blessed with, God's wisdom and guidance.

READER: For the innocent victims of terror, violence or war, that they

may be saved by the efforts of those who work for peace and by the

outstretched hand of God whose love is eternal.

READER: For all who are sick or suffering, homeless or housebound,

that they will know the loving touch of Christ in their lives.

PRIEST: God our Father,

as we celebrate the mystery

of the life, death and resurrection of Christ,

grant that he may dwell in us and we in him,

for he is Lord for ever and ever.
