PRIEST: As we seek to prepare our hearts and our world for the coming of the Lord let us turn to our loving Father:

READER: For the Church, that all who follow Christ will heed his call to repentance and be ready to greet him when he returns in glory. (pause) Lord in your mercy

- READER: For our world, that people will be more willing to share the earth's resources so that the basic needs of all will be met. (*pause*) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For ourselves, that the gift of Christ's presence in the Eucharist may be a constant reminder to us to share our lives with those we meet. (*pause*) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For our own parish community, especially those who are sick, troubled or bereaved, that they will be strengthened by the knowledge of Christ's love. (pause) Lord in your mercy
- READER: For refugees, asylum seekers and all who are far from home, that the loving mercy of God will preserve and support them. (*pause*) Lord in your mercy
- PRIEST: Heavenly Father, you are our strength and our protection. Open our hearts to your grace and lead us to your Kingdom. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord.
