may hunger and thirst for what is right.

READER: For all who are unemployed that, their self-esteem undiminished,

they may soon find suitable and rewarding work.

that God may work in their hearts and direct their minds

to work for the common good.

READER: For our own parish community, that we may always give

faithful witness by reflecting Christ's gentle mercy

in our daily living.

READER: For all who are sick or suffering, lonely or infirm,

that God's love will raise them up with healing and compassion.

PRIEST: God our Father,

you sent your Son among us, born of Mary.

May our response to your Word be deep and true so that we might make him known to the world,

for he is Lord forever and ever.
