READER: For our own community of faith, that we may accept

the challenge to model our lives on the life of Christ,

in response to his call to lead lives of holiness.

Lord in your mercy...

READER: For all who are sick or suffering, lonely or housebound,

that they will draw hope from the coming of the Christ-child.

PRIEST: God of everlasting love,

we ask you to answer our prayers

and pray that only your will be done in and through us.

We ask this in his name, Christ Jesus, our Lord.
