PRIEST: Having listened to God's word we turn in prayer to the Lord,

READER: For our own parish community, that we may be Christ present

in our world today - 'salt of the earth' and 'light of the world'.

(pause)

READER: For all who are sick or suffering, elderly or housebound,

that they will be comforted by the knowledge of God's love.

(pause)

PRIEST: God our Father,

your love for us surpasses all our hopes and desires.

Forgive our failings, keep us in your peace

and lead us in the way of salvation. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
