READER: **For our own community, that each of us will reflect  
the love of Christ by the way we live our lives.**  
*(pause)*  
**Lord in your mercy**

READER: **For all who are sick or housebound,  
and for those who are bereaved,  
that they will be strengthened  
by the knowledge of Christ's love for them.**  
*(pause)*  
**Lord in your mercy**

PRIEST: God our Father,  
you have revealed your love for us  
in the death and Resurrection of Jesus your Son.  
Increase our love for one another  
that we may be your disciples in name and in truth.  
We make this prayer through Christ our Lord.
