READER: For ourselves, that we may encounter Christ in this Eucharist

and reflect his love to all those we meet today.

(pause)

READER: For the sick, the housebound, the lonely and the bereaved,

that they will be comforted by the knowledge of

Christ's unconditional love for them.

PRIEST: God our Father,

Send your Spirit of truth into our hearts that we may always reject what is false,

live by the commands of Christ,

and be true to the love you have shown us. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.
