PRIEST: As we begin our Lenten journey we turn in prayer to God our Father

asking for his help as we prepare to celebrate the Resurrection at Easter:

READER: For the Church, that she may be a sign of God's light and goodness

in our world, and a beacon of hope for the most vulnerable.

READER: For all who are preparing to be baptised at Easter

and all who will be received into full communion with the Church: that they will always recognise the presence of Christ in their lives.

READER: For each of us as we prepare to keep Lent Fast day on Friday

that we may have a true Spirit of self-denial

and be content with less so that others may have more.

(pause)

READER: For all who suffer violence, fear or desperation,

that they will be strengthened through the mercy of God

and the support of God's people.

(pause)

Lord in your mercy

READER: For our brothers and sisters everywhere

that the Holy Spirit will inspire and challenge us to live out our call to be 'a poor Church for the poor'.

(pause)

Lord in your mercy

READER: For all who are sick or suffering in any way,

that they will be strengthened by the knowledge of Christ's love.

(pause)

Lord in your mercy

PRIEST: God our Father

in every age you call a people

to hear your word and to do your will.

Open our eyes to your deeds

and our ears to the sound of your call

so that our every act may increase our sharing

in the new life you offer to us.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.
