PRIEST:	At the beginning of the new year we turn to God asking that he will continue to pour out his Spirit upon us:
READER:	For the whole Church, that this coming year will find that we who follow Christ are more closely united in our discipleship of the Lord. ( <i>pause</i> ) Lord in your mercy
READER:	For peace on earth, that the peace which Christ brings will be a reality for all peoples. ( <i>pause</i> ) Lord in your mercy
READER:	For all mothers, especially those who suffer, that they may be strong in faith, tender in love and courageous in hope. ( <i>pause</i> ) Lord in your mercy
READER:	For all those in our community who will receive the Sacraments this coming year. For those who will be baptised, confirmed, married, anointed, and for those who will receive their first Holy Communion, that the seal of God's Holy Spirit will transform them into the image of Christ. ( <i>pause</i> ) Lord in your mercy
READER:	For our own parish community, that it will be a community built on love and a powerful witness to the presence of God. ( <i>pause</i> ) Lord in your mercy
PRIEST:	Lord our God, you come very near to us in the Child born of the Virgin Mary. In the depths of darkness she gave birth to Light; in the depths of silence she brought forth the Word. Grant that we, who ponder these things in our hearts, may recognise in her child our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns forever and ever.
