may lead us to the joy of rising again.

READER: For all those preparing to be received into full communion with the Church,

that they may come to the celebration of Easter renewed in mind and heart.

READER: For all gathered here to celebrate this Mass,

that we may keep Holy Week well and so be drawn more deeply

into the saving mystery of Christ's death and Resurrection.

READER: For the sick and the suffering, the elderly and infirm,

that they will experience the healing touch of Christ.

PRIEST: God our Father, you anointed Jesus your Son

to bear our sins, to encourage the weary, to raise up and restore a fallen world.

May the paschal mystery of Christ's death and Resurrection be a reality in our lives.
