Greeting

Penitential Rite

As buds uncurl and flowers open their faces to the sun, turn us to the light and warmth of your presence, that in confidence we may confess our sin:

- What is blocking the light?
- What would help the light to shine again?
- Are their areas of my life where I choose to hold onto the dark?

Open the eyes of my heart Lord Open the eyes of my heart I want to see you. I want to see you.

In what ways have I damaged my relationships with other people by my attitude or behaviour, my insensitivity or selfishness? R/.

Have there been times when I have not cared about the injustices in our world or acted against injustice within my own community of home or parish? R/.

Do I hold onto past hurts and refuse to forgive, letting them fester and control how I act with other people? R/.

Am I so determined to do things my own way that I do not care about how it might hurt other people? R/.

Have I abused or attacked or condemned others for being weaker than myself or because I dislike their way of doing things? R/.

Are there things that I could do to make life better for friends, family or colleagues but fail to do because I am more concerned with myself? R/.

Lord, my eyes deceive me, my ears mislead me, my tongue lets me down, my thoughts are confused unless you are with me, unless you direct my looking, speaking, hearing, and all I think and say and am.

Lord, I ask you to enter that fraction of time before I think or speak, so that knowledge of your presence may influence all I do.
