PRIEST: Like the psalmist, we know that God has always been

our refuge, our source of strength,

we will endeavour to recognise and serve Christ in others.

READER: For the sick, the suffering, the lonely and the bereaved,

that they will know the healing touch of Christ.

PRIEST: Loving Father, we are the work of your hands;

free us from every kind of slavery, above all the slavery of sin,

that we may come to enjoy the true freedom of the children of God.

We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.
